
WHEREAS, all transfer procedures as outlined by state statute and local ordinances have been completed satisfactorily.

RESOLUTION FOR INCREASING YEAR 2020 TEMPORARY BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS

WHEREAS N.J.S.A.40A: 4-20 states that in addition to the temporary appropriations necessary for the period prior to the adoption of the budget and regular appropriations, the governing body may, by resolution adopted by a 2/3 vote of the full membership thereof, make emergency temporary appropriations for any purpose for which appropriations may lawfully be made for the period between the beginning of the fiscal year and the adoption of the budget for said year, and WHEREAS the amount of such emergency appropriation shall be included under the correct heading in the budget as adopted, and;

WHEREAS there is a need to provide additional funds for Township operations, and, WHEREAS adequate provision for such funding was not made in the temporary budget

WHEREAS the total emergency temporary resolutions adopted in the year 2020 pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 96, P.L. 1951 (N.J.S.A.40A:4-20) including the increase represented by this resolution total \$ 238,151.13 , in addition to the temporary budgets adopted January 1, 2020 in the amount of \$352,476.37, on January 30, 2020 for \$25,052.00 and February 11, 2020 for \$14,000 for a Year to Date Temporary Budget of \$629,679.50.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township of Shrewsbury (not less than 2/3 affirmatively concurring) that the items of appropriation appearing on the list be included in the temporary budget for the year 2020, and that in accordance with the Statute such item of appropriation will be included in the 2020 budget as finally adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that two certified copies of this resolution be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.

**RESOLUTION CONCERNING VACATION TIME REQUESTED BY CHARLES BRANDON METZ,
PUBLIC WORKS SUPERVISOR OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SHREWSBURY**

WHEREAS, Charles Brandon Metz is a full time employee of the Township of Shrewsbury in the Public Works Department and was hired on a probationary basis by Resolution of October 22, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Charles Brandon Metz has requested based on his many years of experience in public works as a public employee he be provided and allowed 25 days of vacation per year or the equivalency under the Personnel Handbook employee of 20 years; and

WHEREAS, Charles Brandon Metz met with the Township Committee in Executive Session per Resolution allowing for said personnel matter discussion of February 11, 2020 and the Township Committee offered Mr. Metz a compromise on vacation provided by letter of February 21, 2020, which was accepted by Mr. Metz by email.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to the aforesaid Executive Session in recognition that although Mr. Metz has only worked for the Township for a short period of time has been in Public Service for the equivalency of 20 years, the Township Committee hereby authorizes the following vacation time adjustment:


1. Charles Brandon Metz would be entitled to two weeks' vacation until the Township Committee performs its annual employee evaluation of his performance by June 30, 2020.
2. If the annual evaluation is satisfactory in all areas with no negative remarks or conditions, Charles Brandon Metz would be entitled to an additional two weeks or four weeks in total until the end of his probationary period; which is October 22, 2020.
3. Charles Brandon Metz, if approved on permanent status on the anniversary date of October 22, 2020, will receive an additional one week vacation, for a total of five (5) weeks per year.
4. All vacation time must be taken after consent of the governing body based on the workforce time of other employees and their availability in the Public Works Department at the time of chosen vacation time.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to Charles Brandon Metz within seven days of the date of this Resolution.
