WHEREAS such a resolution should designate the individual authorized to ensure the application is properly completed and timely filed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Shrewsbury that the Township of Shrewsbury hereby authorizes and endorses the submission of the recycling tonnage grant application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, and designates Adam Hubeny, certified recycling coordinator, to ensure that the application is properly filed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the monies received from the recycling tonnage grant be deposited in a dedicated recycling trust fund to be used solely for the purposes of recycling.
